- We have participated in cleanup activities at Bear Hill Camp
- We are working on the development of pending new horse trails at the park
- We continue work on the possibility of a horse camping area with a fenced area and water. A site has been selected and clearing has begun.

FROM THE SOUTH—

Take Rte 93 N to Exit 9N (Hooksett) - Take Rte 3 through Hooksett to Allenstown and take a right on Rte 28

FROM THE NORTH—

Take Rte 93 S to Exit 13 (Rte 3S) Go through Concord until you get to Allenstown and make a left on Rte 28

FOLLOW RTE 28 for about 4 miles and you will see a sign on the right for Bear Brook State Park—Take a right on Deerfield Road into the park and stay on Deerfield Rd, pass through the first Ranger Station, pass New Rye Road and continue until you see a right on Podunk Rd. There will be State Park Signs and a sign for Hayes Field. Pavement will turn to gravel and Hayes Field will be approximately 3/4 of a mile down on the right
